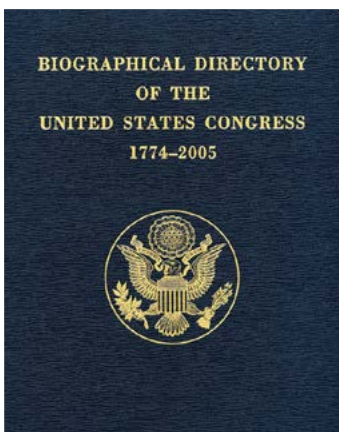


The *Women in Congress* and *Black Americans in Congress* books contain biographical profiles, historical essays and data, and an array of photographs and artifacts.
